Part I: Moving Personal Collections to Image Groups

Note: If you don't complete these steps before image groups are copied in February, you can still use the copy tool to transfer personal content to JSTOR until August 1, 2024. See Copy Image Groups from Artstor for more information.

- 1. Access the Sojourner Truth Library at https://library.newpaltz.edu
 - a. It is best to access Artstor via STL's website
- 2. Click the **Databases** tab
- 3. Select Artstor Digital Archive Collection
- 4. Click **Login** to **Artstor** at the upper right
- 5. Enter the **email** with which you signed up for Artstor and your **password**
 - a. Note: You may have started an Artstor account with another email such as gmail or older email services—even Hotmail or AOL!
 - b. If you cannot remember your Artstor password, Click Forgot password and retrieve it from your email account.
- Open the Browse drop-down menu and select Personal Collections (continued)

7. Click **Personal Collections**

- a. **Note:** The default number of images per page 48, but you can display up to 72 items per page.
- b. If you have more images than 72 in your personal collection, you can repeat these steps for each page, by adding Images to an existing group (see below and as demonstrated in the video).
- 8. Open the Organize drop-down menu and select Select all on page
- 9. Open the **Organize** drop-down menu once again
- 10. Select Save selections to a new group
 - a. In the CREATE NEW GROUP dialog box
 - i. Add a **Title**
 - ii. Add a **Description** if you like.
 - iii. Make sure Sharing Permissions are set to Only Me.
 - iv. Click Create

Part II: Add More Personal Images to an Image Group

- 1. While still in **Personal Collections**, click the **page navigation arrows** to move to the next page of up to 72 images.
- 2. Open the **Organize** drop-down menu and select **Select all on page**
- 3. Open the **Organize** drop-down menu once again
 - a. Select Save selections to an existing group
 - i. In the ADD 72 IMAGES TO GROUP dialog box
 - 1. Select the group you just created from **Recent Groups**
 - 2. Click ADD
 - 3. Confirmation will pop up.
 - b. **OR Save selections to a new group**, if you want to organize your images into different image groups, see above, steps 10 a) i-iii.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 as needed until all your images are saved in a Group
